COMMUNITY SERVICE NEEDS VOLUNTEERS

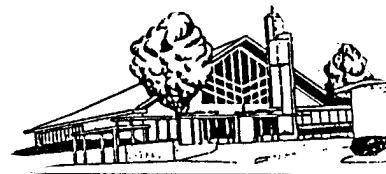
